Dear Parents

This is an outline of the level and purpose of fees for students attending John Therry Catholic College. Government Funding covers approximately 80% of the recurrent costs associated with running a Catholic High School. The 20% "gap", plus loan commitments associated with building; need to be met by parent contributions. A breakdown of the 2020 school fees:

<b>Tuition Fee</b>	<i>Teachers' salaries and the day to day running costs of the school (water, electricity, paper etc)</i>
<b>Building Fund</b>	<i>This is a contribution used solely for the repayment of loans on the school buildings. (Equivalent to a mortgage payment)</i>
<b>Student Administration Fee</b>	<i>Covers the cost of the school planner issued to each student and other general administration costs.</i>
<b>Technology Levy</b>	<i>This contributes towards the costs of maintaining technology hardware, software, access to the internet and apps for iPad's/Chromebooks.</i>
<b>Subject Resource Fee</b>	<i>This covers the cost of all other books and equipment which are purchased in bulk and issued to your child for their personal use. The alternative would be for you to purchase these items which would be at a greater cost. This also assists in covering the cost of other textbooks (years 7-10) issued to your child.</i>
<b>Academic Course Fees</b>	<i>This goes towards offsetting the cost of consumables and textbooks (years 11-12) used by your child in practical courses e.g. Materials used in textiles.</i>
<b>Sport Levy</b>	<i>The sports levy covers most costs associated with travelling to sport and external coaches/instructors that visit John Therry. This also covers use of buses for sport and other extracurricular activities such as debating, chess and social justice events.</i>
<b>Parents &amp; Friends Levy</b>	<i>The P&amp;F Levy has replaced fundraising events. The P&amp;F Levy contributes to one or more major projects in the school year. Fundraising and Charitable works are limited at John Therry to 1 per term. Term 1 Caritas Term 2 St Vincent de Paul Winter Appeal Term 3 Marist Solidarity Term 3 Marist Solidarity</i>

## **PAYMENT OF SCHOOL FEES**

All school fees are due **30 days after invoice date** at the beginning of the year. Payment arrangements can be made to have account paid over the year but this **must be arranged** with the finance office otherwise fees are expected to be paid in full by due date. Statements will be sent monthly. Our preferred option for payment is BPay however payments may be made in a lump sum or in instalments (by arrangement). Direct Debit facilities are also available, simply contact the school finance office. The school finance office has an EFTPOS machine available for payments.

A deduction on the Tuition fee only, for the second and subsequent child of a family attending the school applies. All families however are required to pay the Administration fee, Subject Resource fee and Technology Levy for **each** child attending the school. Deductions on the Tuition fee are:

25%	for the second child attending the school.
50%	for the third child attending the school.
100%	for the fourth and subsequent children attending the school.

In 2020 a deduction on the Building Fund for the second and subsequent child of a family attending the school applies:

50%	for the second child attending the school.
100%	for the all subsequent children attending the school.

- Wish to organise a direct debit to ensure fees are paid by the first week of December.*
- Need assistance with calculating this amount.  
Note: Direct Debit forms are available from the finance office or the school website. They will be lodged with Catholic Development Fund in Wollongong.*
- Fee Arrangements are to be completed, checked and verified in writing each calendar year eg Direct Debits, Applications for Concessions or Extensions to pay under the CEO Fee policy.*
- Please contact the school Finance Officer, Alison Crawford, to discuss any matters in relation to school fees.*
- Any family experiencing difficulties regarding the payment of fees must contact the Finance Office to arrange a meeting with the Principal. Such matters are always treated in the strictest confidence.*
